The Government and Calderdale Council guidance around attendance has had some recent changes. These changes are being introduced in all schools. We continue to monitor all children's attendance but we now meet more regularly with our Education Welfare Officer to discuss individual children's attendance.

- Letters of concern will be sent to parents from school where attendance is becoming a concern.
- Holiday fines will be sent to children who go on holiday in term time.
- Parents may be invited into school to discuss their child's attendance and asked to sign an attendance contract.
- Our EWO will write to parents where a child's attendance continues to fall.
- School can ask for medical evidence for a child's absences to be authorised.
- **NEW** — Fines for poor attendance can also now be issued for children deemed as persistently absent (where their attendance is below 90%).
